A special meeting of the Maxwell City Council was held April 3, 2020. In order to help stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus, this special meeting of the Maxwell City Council was held electronically. Chapter 21.8 of the Iowa Code does permit an electronic meeting where all members participate remotely when an in-person meeting is impossible or impractical, which is certainly true during this crisis. On March 19, 2020, Governor Reynolds issued a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency which included a suspension of Iowa laws that would prevent the use of electronic meetings or the limitation on the number of people present at an in-person meeting site. Therefore, only Mayor Hudson, Council Member Steve Gast and City Clerk Deb Hayes were present at Maxwell City Hall at 107 Main St. The agenda and the City’s social media had this message posted more than 24 hours in advance to give instructions on how others could participate in the meeting. Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the City of Maxwell will be holding this city council meeting electronically via a conference call.
