MAXWELL CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
WEDNESDAY, JULY 27, 2022, 6:00 P.M. AT THE
AMERICAN LEGION HALL

1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Hudson at 6:00 P.M.
2. Roll call was answered by Lauryn Myers, Meggen Lawrence, and Doug Miller. Visitors: Wes Farrand, Bob Pritchard, Catherine Spencer, Rich Hansen, Ben & Jan Larson, Heath Mahlow, Jake Thompson, Anthony Benton, Diana Beckman, and Rick & Yvonne Herrmann.
3. A motion to approve the agenda was moved by Lawrence and seconded by Myers. 3 ayes.
4. Open House for Discussion on Preliminary Plans for Woodlawn St Drainage Project. – Jameson introduced Wes Farrand from Snyder & Associate. Wes discussed the 2 options that were presented to council. The 1st option was the open ditch with culvert under streets and driveways. The ditches would be approximately 15 feet wide. Costs of this option would be \$100,000-\$125,000. The concerns with this option were water standing in the bottom of the ditch causing a mosquito breeding ground, hard to mow or weed eat, and water going over the road. The 2nd option would be to run a series of storm sewer pipes along Woodlawn to Rock Creek replacing existing culverts. Costs of this option would be \$210,000-\$265,000. The disadvantage of this option is the price and running the pipe underground. These options would allow further benefits for the rest of Woodlawn St. There were discussion on grants. There are not many grants for this small of a project. The residents have given the council some good input and items to consider when looking at this project.
5. Adjourn – Lawrence moved to adjourn. Myers seconded. 3 ayes. 7:00 P.M.
